Savings Within Reach offers increased cash incentives for select energy-efficiency upgrades—available to Oregon residents who meet Energy Trust’s moderate-income guidelines.

Floor insulation	\$0.40 per square foot
Ductless heat pump with a minimum efficiency of HSPF 9.0	\$1,000
Heat pump upgrade with a minimum efficiency of HSPF 9.0	\$550
Heat pump upgrade with a minimum efficiency of HSPF 9.5	\$800
Heat pump with a minimum efficiency of HSPF 9.0 (when replacing an existing electric furnace)	\$750
Heat pump with a minimum efficiency of HSPF 9.5 (when replacing an existing electric furnace)	\$1,000
High-efficiency gas furnace with a 90 percent AFUE or greater	\$550



HOW TO PARTICIPATE

1 Establish your eligibility

To qualify for Savings Within Reach, you must live in a single-family or manufactured home located in Oregon and heated by Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, NW Natural or Cascade Natural Gas.

We will provide you with a selection of participating contractors in your area, or you can view a list of participating contractors by visiting the Energy Trust website.

Please note: For rental properties, the homeowner or property owner must approve work before it begins.

2 Install energy-efficient home improvements

Prior to beginning improvements, your contractor will ask you to sign an Income Verification form to confirm your eligibility to participate in the initiative. All improvements must be installed by an approved Savings Within Reach participating contractor.

3 Sign the incentive form and pay your invoice

After installation, your contractor will submit your paperwork and the invoices for your improvements to Energy Trust. Incentive amounts must not exceed the cost of your improvement project. Your Energy Trust incentive will be paid directly to your contractor, who will deduct the incentive amount from your invoice, reducing your out-of-pocket expense. You are required to pay the balance of the invoice.

OTHER OPPORTUNITIES

If your income is below the Savings Within Reach moderate-income range, you may be better served by Oregon's Weatherization Assistance Program, administered by Oregon Housing and Community Services.

Energy Trust offers separate cash-back incentives for energy-efficiency improvements to homeowners whose income is above the Savings Within Reach moderate-income range.

FINANCING

Energy Trust is working with Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, NW Natural and local nonprofit lender Craft3 to provide On-Bill Repayment to help you complete home energy-efficiency upgrades.

If you primarily heat your home with Cascade Natural Gas, talk with your bank or credit union to see if they offer loans for energy improvement projects.
